This office received on August 5, 2019 a notice of appeal from your client, Tina R. Harbin. Pursuant to Rule 264 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, you will remain counsel of record until and unless you or Ms. Harbin file a motion for you to be relieved as counsel. And all future filings must be submitted by you.

The following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or the appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption must contain the name of the appellate court where the notice of appeal is to be filed, the name and title of the judge, the names, addresses and phone numbers of all counsel in the case.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II

of the SCACR, specifically showing service of the notice of appeal to all counsel of record.

- The judge's signature pages for two of the orders provided were not included: The "Special Referee's Order and Judgment of Foreclosure and Sale" and the "Order of Reference". Please provide complete copies of these orders.
