



ORDER

On August 9, 2019, this Court denied Appellant's motion to stay the writ of ejectment because Appellant failed to show he first made the motion to the circuit court and that he has complied with the undertaking requirement set forth in section 27-40-800 of the South Carolina Code (2007). Appellant has now filed a second motion to stay the writ of ejectment, which we construe as a petition for panel review pursuant to Rule 241(d)(7), SCACR. After careful consideration, the Court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been overlooked or disregarded. Therefore, we adhere to the denial of Appellant's motion to stay.
