ORDER

Petitioner has filed a documents entitled "Notice of Appeal" and "Brief of Appellant." Since petitioner is seeking review of the decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals in Appellate Case Number 2019-000086, these documents have been construed as a petition for a writ of certiorari under Rule 242 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR).¹

The motion to proceed in forma paueris is denied. *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). Petitioner shall pay the \$250 filing fee required by Rule 242(c), SCACR, within twenty (20) days of the date of this order.

Finally, petitioner has not filed an appendix having the content required by Rule 242(e), SCACR. Therefore, petitioner shall serve and file the required appendix within twenty (20) days of the date of this order. Petitioner need only file one copy of the appendix with this Court.
