1. That the Violatee was in Spartanburg County Community Supervision for 5 Years (01.03.14 Date thru 01.02.19 Date), with only minimum reporting (Initially 3 Month Intervals, then 6 Month Intervals), without any inside, or outside infraction; thus, as per former Agent Faust, then a 'Model Probatee';

2. That the Violatee did file a Last Document (Post Conviction Relief) with the Clerk (General Sessions Court), who did appoint an Attorney (Greenville County Bar), who was to advise as to Hearing Date, which is still pending;

3. That the Violatee did receive only limited US Social Security (Monthly Retirement Amount) during the entire duration of Probation Period; thus being financially unable to render payment; then the Violatee did seek indirect assistance;

4. That the Violatee did resolve entire restitution issue indirectly with the Victim on 01.22.14 Date, via the Inspector (US Weatherization Grant) and the Agent (Spartanburg City Code Enforcement); thus, with this official action, then no Restitution;

5. That the Violatee did resolve entire supervision issue indirectly with the Director (SC Probation Department), as per formal attachment; thus, with this official action, then an alternative; and,

6. that the Violatee did attempt to resolve this probative matter with the Violation (Agent Sandefur) on 05.29.19 Date; thus, since the Director supercedes, then a 'Meet Point' for a grant of dismissal.

Dear THOMAS RAYNES MARETT:

According to our records, you owe the South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services a debt in the amount of \$1750.00, for one or more of the following Supervision accounts, Regular, Intensive, YOA, GPS or E-Monitor. You are hereby notified of the South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services' intention to submit this debt to the South Carolina Department of Revenue for the calendar year 2018 for collection through the Setoff Debt Collection Act if not paid within thirty (30) days from the date of this notice.

The Setoff Debt Collection Act allows the Department of Revenue to deduct, from any refund, this amount plus all costs, including a \$25 administrative fee. If you file a joint return with your spouse, this amount will be deducted from the total joint refund without regard to which spouse incurred the debt or actually withheld the taxes.

The Department of Revenue will utilize the powers granted under Title 12 of the SC Code. You may file a written protest, with the following information, within thirty (30) days from the date of this notice: **your name and address, your social security number, the type of debt in dispute and a detailed statement of all reasons you disagree with the debt amount or dispute that you owe the debt.**

The original written protest must be mailed to the Attention: Offender Account Review and Collections at the South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services at Post Office Box 50666, Columbia, South Carolina 29250.

If you have any questions in regards to this letter, please **contact your probation agent**. If your agency account has been brought up to date, please disregard this letter.
