Dear Mrs. Carpenter:

This is a follow-up letter to the letter that I sent to you on October 04, 2018. The October letter was about the Magistrate Court Return filed in the above case, and the fact that only a small part of the Return was posted on the state wide data base maintained by the Supreme Court. I asked you back in October to please see if you could get ALL of the Return posted on the State's data base. There was a TRANSCRIPT made and included with the return. Does the clerk's office have the transcript? As of today's date, the transcript is still missing. Instead of posting the transcript, your office only posted the letter sent to you on October 04, 2018.

I suspect part of the problem lies with one of your employees, Mr. Douglas Atkinson. In the past I have taken note of the fact that Mr. Atkinson will not do filings in the above case unless he checks with someone else about what to do. And Mr. Atkinson does not check with the elected clerk of court, but he does check with Mr. B. Michael Brackett, the opposing counsel in the above case, and always in an ex parte manner.

As you should well remember, or if you do not remember, the Record shows that the Magistrate Return was held back and not filed until the Return was at least one year late, and then was published only a day or two before the hearing in the circuit court about the matter, which meant that I did not have time to study the transcript prior to the circuit court hearing. Mr. Brackett has the transcript, but does not want anyone to see the transcript. These matters are STILL pending in the South Carolina Court of Appeals, and everyone needs access to the transcript. Please post the transcript, and all of the other parts of the Record, for use by everyone. If the entire Record cannot be included in the state data base, please state the reason, if any you have, as to why this case cannot be handled in an ordinary way.


