

Personally appear before me, a magistrate of this county one, Det. J. Richardson, who first being duly sworn deposed and says that, Allen Angelo Fields, did within this county and state on the September 13th 2016 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particular:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE

Possession of a Knife during the Commission of a Violent Crime (16-23-490)

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named did commit the crime set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

On September 13th 2016 at 1644 hours, while at 852 Orleans Road (TD Bank), which is in the city and county of Charleston, SC the above named defendant, Allen Angelo Fields, did knowingly, willingly, and unlawfully violate South Carolina State Statute: 16-23-490 (Possession of a Knife during the Commission of a Violent Crime) in the following particulars:

On the above date and time TD Bank Monitoring contacted Charleston County Consolidated Dispatch and reported four panic signal activations from the above location. Multiple calls from TD Bank employees of the business confirmed that the business was just robbed by a suspect who brandished a knife and demanded money upon approaching the teller booths. Employees stated that upon the suspect entering the bank, he immediately approached the first teller station adjacent to the front door and produced a white plastic bag identified to be a white SUNOCO shopping bag in his right hand.

Once face to face with the teller in an unobstructed booth the suspect opens the bag and immediately states to the first teller to give him "all the money and no one will get hurt". The suspect then pulled out a large knife contained within a brown leather sheath and pointed it at the teller. In fear for her safety the teller then surrenders the cash from the teller drawer placing it into the suspect's open bag. The suspect then walks to the next teller booth approaching another employee and demands all the cash in that register repeating the same demand. After receiving the available money from each teller booth the suspect then turns around and walks out of the bank after less than two minutes inside. An internal audit of each cash drawer indicated that the suspect fled with \$5,356.00 total from the robbery.

AFFIDAVIT CONTINUATION

REASON FOR AFFIANT'S CONTINUED BELIEF

The same TD tellers with a view through the drive through of the rear exterior of the building saw the suspect as he fled run around the building where he jumped the chain link fence adjacent to the parking lot of the SUNOCO gas station located at 1987 Sam Rittenberg Blvd. The suspect was seen entering into the rear passenger side door of an awaiting black Chevy Impala. The vehicle was then seen fleeing the parking lot making a right onto Sam Rittenberg Blvd at a high rate of speed.

Witnesses present inside of the bank at the time of the robbery provided the suspect's description as a black male, believed to be 30-40 years of age, approximately 5'10-6'00" in height, weighting approximately 200 lbs., with a goatee style beard on his face. Witnesses also stated the suspect wore a black baseball cap, and blue lensed sunglasses to conceal his appearance during the robbery.

Photograph screen captures of the suspect at the time of the robbery screen shot captures depicting his appearance was released in a media release for an attempt to identify. Information obtained from multiple crime stoppers tip indicated that the defendant (Allen Angelo Fields) physically matched suspect's description as seen on the media release. According to SC DMV the defendant stands at 5'11" and is approximately 177lbs fitting the age range, and has a distinctive inch long goatee.

During the course of the investigation a search of the defendant's Facebook [Bubba Fields] revealed an account post on 9/26/16 stating verbatim "Chilling with the FAM dam its good fuck u snitches". Further investigation revealed witnesses (to be named at a later date) who have known the defendant for the majority of his life, were presented with photographs from the interior surveillance of the robbery. After viewing the photographs, the witnesses positively identified the defendant by name and sight as the suspect seen in the photographs as the person who committed the robbery. The witnesses also observed a SC DMV photo of the defendant and confirmed that he was indeed the person inside of the bank. The defendant was also identified by his moniker "Lil Bubba.

Armed Robbery is classified as a violent crime according to South Carolina Code of Laws (16-1-60) as a violent crime. During the commission of the robbery the victims did state and the interior video surveillance reflects that the defendant was in possession of a knife which he used to facilitate the robbery.

The above is true and believable based upon the statements gathered from TD bank employees, witnesses on scene, review of the interior bank surveillance and SUNOCO gas station footage, information obtained from SC DMV, the Facebook account belonging to the defendant, as well as the positive identifications of the defendant, in conjunction with the investigations of the Charleston Police Department.

AFFIDAVIT

Personally appear before me, a magistrate of this county one, Det. J. Richardson, who first being duly sworn deposed and says that, Allen Angelo Fields, did within this county and state on the September 13th 2016 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particular:

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named did commit the crime set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

On September 13th 2016 at 1644 hours, while at 852 Orleans Road (TD Bank), which is in the city and county of Charleston, SC the above named defendant, Allen Angelo Fields, did knowingly, willingly, and unlawfully violate South Carolina State Statute: 16-11-330 (Armed Robbery) in the following particulars:

On the above date and time TD Bank Monitoring contacted Charleston County Consolidated Dispatch and reported four panic signal activations from the above location. Multiple calls from TD Bank employees of the business confirmed that the business was just robbed by a suspect who brandished a knife and demanded money upon approaching the teller booths. Employees stated that upon the suspect entering the bank, he immediately approached the first teller station adjacent to the front door and produced a white plastic bag identified to be a white SUNOCO shopping bag in his right hand.

Once face to face with the teller in an unobstructed booth the suspect opens the bag and immediately states to the first teller to give him "all the money and no one will get hurt". The suspect then pulled out a large knife contained within a brown leather sheath and pointed it at the teller. In fear for her safety the teller then surrenders the cash from the teller drawer placing it into the suspect's open bag. The suspect then walks to the next teller booth approaching another employee and demands all the cash in that register repeating the same demand. After receiving the available money from each teller booth the suspect then turns around and walks out of the bank after less than two minutes inside. An internal audit of each cash drawer indicated that the suspect fled with \$5,356.00 total from the robbery.

AFFIDAVIT CONTINUATION

REASON FOR AFFIANT'S CONTINUED BELIEF

The same TD tellers with a view through the drive through of the rear exterior of the building saw the suspect as he fled run around the building where he jumped the chain link fence adjacent to the parking lot of the SUNOCO gas station located at 1987 Sam Rittenberg Blvd. The suspect was seen entering into the rear passenger side door of an awaiting black Chevy Impala. The vehicle was then seen fleeing the parking lot making a right onto Sam Rittenberg Blvd at a high rate of speed.

Witnesses present inside of the bank at the time of the robbery provided the suspect's description as a black male, believed to be 30-40 years of age, approximately 5'10-6'00" in height, weighting approximately 200 lbs., with a goatee style beard on his face. Witnesses also stated the suspect wore a black baseball cap, and blue lensed sunglasses to conceal his appearance during the robbery.

Photograph screen captures of the suspect at the time of the robbery screen shot captures depicting his appearance was released in a media release for an attempt to identify. Information obtained from multiple crime stoppers tip indicated that the defendant (Allen Angelo Fields) physically matched the suspect's description as seen on the media release. According to SC DMV the defendant stands at 5'11" and is approximately 177lbs fitting the age range, and has a distinctive inch long goatee.

During the course of the investigation a search of the defendant's Facebook [Bubba Fields] revealed an account post on 9/26/16 stating verbatim "Chilling with the FAM dam its good fuck u snitches". Further investigation revealed witnesses (to be named at a later date) who have known the defendant for the majority of his life, were presented with photographs from the interior surveillance of the robbery. After viewing the photographs, the witnesses positively identified the defendant by name and sight as the suspect seen in the photographs as the person who committed the robbery. The witnesses also observed a SC DMV photo of the defendant and confirmed that he was indeed the person inside of the bank. The defendant was also identified by his moniker "Lil Bubba."

The above is true and believable based upon the statements gathered from TD bank employees, witnesses on scene, review of the interior bank surveillance and SUNOCO gas station footage, information obtained from SC DMV, the Facebook account belonging to the defendant, as well as the positive identifications of the defendant, in conjunction with the investigations of the Charleston Police Department.
