Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed:

- A proof of service has not been provided showing the notice of appeal has been timely served upon the respondent(s) and the clerk of court for Lee County. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
