Mr. Howard:

I am in receipt of your letter requesting the above-mentioned transcript. I have reviewed my records and estimate that the transcript will be approximately 165 pages. Based on the current rate of \$4.25 per page, the cost will be \$701.25, plus \$7.35 for postage or \$40 if you would like me to e-mail the transcript. Under our rules, I have 60 days in which to complete the transcript.

Upon receipt of a certified check or money order (no personal checks), the 60 days begin.
