**MOTION TO STAY APPEAL**

Pursuant to Rules 240 and 263, SCACR, the Appellant asks the Court to issue an order holding the deadlines for perfecting this appeal in abeyance for a period of 60 days to allow the parties to seek mediation. The Appellant is willing to mediate and has expressed the same to counsel for the Respondents. Counsel for the Respondents has previously expressed interest in mediation but has not yet communicated that his clients have consented to the same.

The Appellant wishes to avoid incurring the expenses associated with perfecting this appeal while mediation is a realistic possibility, and she therefore requests that the Court issue an order staying the deadlines for perfecting this appeal for a period of 60 days and requiring the Appellant to report to the Court either at the expiration of this deadline or as soon as the parties agree to the mediation process.
