

Dear Sir or Madam:

I am writing to supplement my application for admission to practice *pro hac vice* in this case before the South Carolina Supreme Court in the PCR Appeal of *Mikal Mahdi v. State* (No. 2013-000183). (A motion for my admission has been submitted by Teresa L. Norris and is currently pending.) The application correctly lists all the jurisdictions to which I have been admitted to practice.
