



LET ALL MEN KNOW BY THESE PRESENT and the Official Record that the within Appellant NOW MOVES this Honorable Court to enlarge the time for filing the Appellant's Initial Brief by reason of the following:

1. Appellant has been unable to work here in and around Metro Columbia, South Carolina, and in Richland County due to the threats placed upon Appellant's life and the stalking reported on record to the Columbia Police Department and SLED.
2. The Transcripts entered into this matter on appeal are completely FAKE, phony and untrue. As such, the Appellant cannot base nor construct the Appellant's initial brief upon what was stated in this transcript regarding the status conference hearing held on multiple motions to dismiss the complaint in the lower court.
3. Accordingly, SCACR 240 provided that the Appellant may seek an enlargement of time to file and serve the Appellant's Initial Brief due to the circumstances as stated above by this instant motion.


