Dear Ms. Kitchings:

The enclosed letter was sent to Pro-SE Francine Laura Lawton and she gave me a copy. As I stated in the letter that was received and stamped June 18, 2019 Phillip Friedrich Moore is now Pro-SE. I retained James Ross Snell and Vicki P. Kousogiannis (ONLY) to submit a brief and Nothing else. His firm was paid in full in Advance to submit the brief. Now, the briefs have been dismissed and stricken from the docket, not to be reviewed. The fact is Mr. Snell was paid a fee in full to submit the brief, final brief and failed to do his duty. V. Claire Allen states in this letter (Enclosed) any correspondence to be filed in this appeal must be filed by counsel. Look at the situation my counsel has put me in today. I only retained Mr. Snell to keep me involved in my parents Probate. Mr. Snell has not submitted anything on the docket to be reviewed. After the briefs were dismissed and stricken, I contacted Mr. Snell. I am not a attorney and did not know what he was trying to explain. What I did understand was that Phillip Friedrich Moore has Nothing on the docket to be reviewed by the Judges on the Appeal. At the end of our conversation Mr. Snell stated that he would submit a paper or document to the Supreme Court. My concern is not with the Supreme Court, it is entirely with the South Carolina Court of Appeals. As I stated above I did not receive a letter I have (enclosed) from V. Claire Allen. I would ask that ALL letters be mailed

with the letters sent by the other Heirs when the Probate opened and let
the alternate (Phillip Friedrich Moore) have the duty, this Probate would
have closed in 8 months. Again, I will state that the Correspondence
I sent June 18, 2019 is NOT CONSIDERED a Brief. These papers sent
are (Solely) based on the Pro-SE's OPINION and the facts that the Pro-SE
received from the Dec. 22, 2015 Hearing. If I could please ask a
Judge (Himself) to notify me with a letter stating the correspondence
I sent as Pro-Se June 18, 2019 will be viewed on the docket. If not,
please give me a reason. 3 of the 5 Heirs Phillip Friedrich Moore, Francine
Laura Lawton and Linda K. Moore (deceased) as Pro-SE's will ask to stay
involved in our parents Probate and review the documents sent
June 18, 2019 from the Dec. 22, 2015 Hearing on the appeal. Please respond
