

Pursuant to Rule 208(7), SCACR, I am hereby advising the court of pertinent and significant authority related to Respondents' brief. The supplemental citation coincides with section III.A. of the Respondents' initial brief (starting on page 9) under the heading "**The circuit court's apportionment of liability was not appealed as to Clemson and therefore is the law of the case as to Respondents.**" In further support of Respondents' position, Respondents direct the court's attention to *Ralph v. McLaughlin*, Op. No. 5681 (Aug. 21, 2019). In that case, the Court of Appeals determined the circuit court erred in failing to apply the specific rulings and findings of fact factual determinations from a previous grant of summary judgment to a third-party defendant as the law of the case. Respondents submit that the same outcome should be reached in this matter.

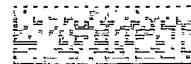
