

**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF AUGUST 30, 2019, DEADLINE FOR FILING
RETURN TO RESPONDENTS' PETITIONS FOR REHEARING**

Following this Court's decision in the above-captioned matter, both Respondents filed Petitions for Rehearing. The Court has requested Appellant respond to the Petitions by August 30, 2019.
