ORDER

After careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the Court has discovered no material fact or principle of law that has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied. However, we modify footnote 11 in Opinion No. 5657 to state the following: "We note that in the present case, the AG did not assert an exemption in his initial response to Pope's July 2011 FOIA request. The record indicates the first assertion of an exemption was in a proposed amended answer dated March 7, 2013, nearly twenty months later. This document was attached to the AG's motion to amend his answer, but the circuit court never expressly ruled on this motion."
