MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Keenan Coakley v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on July 31, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari pursuant to Austin v. State and accompanying appendix in the case of Jonta Green v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on July 26, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of John M. Cureton v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on July 24, 2019. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Drake Edward Campbell with this Court on July 16, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Aaron Young, Sr. with this Court on July 11, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Nathaniel Mitchell v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on July 1, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Jose Reyes Reyes with this Court on June 27, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for


writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of Dean Alton Holcomb v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on June 24, 2019.




5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.


