ORDER

On August 1, 2019, this court issued an order requiring Appellant to serve and file Appellant's final brief and final reply brief within twenty days of the date of the order. This court reminded Appellant that Rule 211 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules requires final briefs to be identical to initial briefs except for the correction of typographical errors and the addition of references to the record on appeal. The order further provided that this court would consider Respondent's motion to dismiss upon receipt of the final briefs or the expiration of twenty days.

Although Appellant has now filed his final brief and final reply brief, Appellant has failed to comply with Rule 211, SCACR, and this court's August 1, 2019 order because Appellant's final briefs differ substantially from Appellant's initial briefs. Accordingly after careful consideration of Respondent's motion to dismiss and the parties' filings throughout this appeal, the motion is granted and this appeal is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided in Rule 221, SCACR.
