

FIRST DEGREE

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on \_\_\_\_\_, 2019,  
the Grand Jurors of Greenville County present upon their oath:

That Michael G. Strother, did in Greenville County, between the dates of May 19, 2017, and May 30, 2017, commit the crime of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, First Degree. To wit: Michael G. Strother, did knowingly use, employ, induce, coerce, encourage or facilitate a minor, (S.M., [REDACTED]), to engage in or assist others to engage in sexual activity for the purpose of producing material in a file that contains a visual representation depicting this activity or appear in a state of sexually explicit nudity, as defined by Section 16-15-375(5) and (6) of the South Carolina Code of Laws. This incident occurred within the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and is in direct violation of Section 16-15-395(A) of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976), as amended.



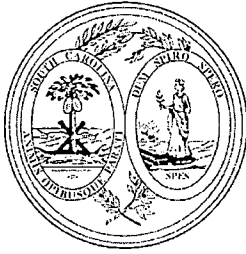
