ORDER

The State has filed a motion seeking a fifth thirty-day extension to serve and file the return to the petition for a writ of certiorari. This request is based on other work related responsibilities of the counsel representing the State.

Under this Court's order dated March 18, 2009, a fourth or subsequent extension will only be granted based on an extraordinary circumstance. The press of other business is simply not sufficient to warrant a fifth extension. While this Court would be perfectly justified in denying the motion in its entirety, an extension to serve and file the return is granted until September 17, 2019.
