MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Lance R. Elam respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension, until October 3, 2019**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Lance R. Elam respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jeremy Renard Webb with this Court on August 15, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Donquavious Dashon Davis v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 10, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of David Eric Dixon v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 10, 2019. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Gartharee Hinson v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 8, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Johnathan Devon Moss with this Court on July 1, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Richard E. Tedford v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 1, 2019.



5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.





