Please be advised that I am requesting that the form that I completed for appointment of attorney be rescinded because I was never informed of any appointment. I contacted SCWCC several times, and I was told that someone would contact me about this issue. Yet, this never happened. Therefore, I will continue to function in the capacity as *Pro se* on my husband's, Albert Bradley's, behalf. As of this date, no changes have been made regarding my legal representation.


In addition, please correct your records to show that Attorney Preston McDaniel and Gerald Malloy were hired May 2011. The attorney-client relationship between myself and Attorney Preston McDaniel was terminated by me in June 2011 because he was not working in the best interests of my husband, Albert Bradley. The attorney-client relationship between myself and Attorney Gerald Malloy was terminated by me in November 2011, for the same reason-failing to act on behalf of his client, Albert Bradley.

Attorney Olin McDougal was appointed by Attorney Scott Roberts to assist with the matters involving the claim of Albert Bradley at the SCWCC. Both attorneys withdrew their representation after their first court appearance in September 2012, and were only active for a very short period (approximately 2 months). The family of Albert Bradley met with Olin McDougal only once, which was for a very brief period prior to the hearing in September 2012.

I have attached a copy of the list that your agency provided to me for contacts for individuals involved in the court reporting of hearings related to this case. Please provide all addresses for the agencies you have listed on your company's letterhead and please sign the document. Tatum and Deborah Thomas Court Reporting, Inc. were contacted by phone. They both informed me that they have no record of this case.

Once again, please make all corrections and provide me with the necessary documentation so that I will be able to comply with the procedures of the SC Court of Appeals.
