I am responding to the letter received from my appointed attorney requesting me to provide in writing any arguable reasons to show grounds for requesting my appeal.

① I filed paperwork for my preliminary evidence hearing and was transported from Greenville County Detention Center to court for said hearing, and my appointed counsel was not present, so hearing was rescheduled for 30 days later. My appointed counsel waived my right to my hearing without my consent, so I was not given A preliminary hearing.

② I requested my appointed counsel to provide any video evidence pertaining to my case multiple times before being placed on trial docket and being forced to accept plea offer or go to trial,

③ Requested that my medical records be obtained by my appointed counsel to prepare medical/mental health defense. Counsel never completed or responded to requests.

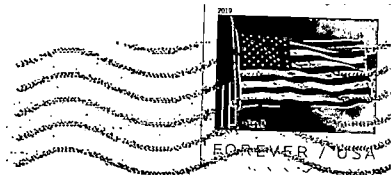
④ I was advised to take A plea by appointed counsel that included "lesser offenses" but was not informed of new CDR codes or sentencing guidelines.
