

In reply to your email dated August 25, 2019 with respect to your transcripts request, In Re: Rufus L. Griffin vs. Thomas Mosley, case number 2016-CP-19-00141, hearings held before the Honorable Judge Alison Lee on March 18, 2019; and Jocelyn Newman on November 7, 2016 at the Edgefield County Courthouse, Edgefield, South Carolina.
