
Counsel for Defendant Delta Air Lines, Inc. ("Delta") filed a Motion to Strike Portions of Appellants' Initial Brief and Designation of Matter, and Request to Stay Time Limits for Filing Respondent's Initial Brief on May 24, 2019. At that time the Court was advised that a transcript was not provided by the Appellant and Delta requested the Court to direct the Appellant to provide the transcript.

On August 2, 2019, the Court Denied Delta's Motion to strike; however the issue of the transcript was not addressed in the order.

On August 15, 2019, Counsel for Delta requested directly from the Appellant a copy of the transcript. The Appellant denied the request, but stated he would consent to an order from the Court compelling the production of the transcript.
