Dear Mr. Shearouse:

On August 2, 2019, the Court granted Mr. Jamison's motion to relieve undersigned counsel and proceed pro se. The Court ordered Appellate Defense to remain associated for obtaining and paying for any necessary transcripts and records. The Court also ordered Appellate Defense to mail Mr. Jamison a copy of the transcripts and any other records in our possession that were necessary for the preparation of the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix.

The writ of certiorari and appendix were ordered to be due within thirty days of Appellate Defense mailing Petitioner his transcript. Undersigned counsel mailed these documents to Petitioner on August 9, 2019, and therefore, the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed today.

Appellate Defense will notify the Court as soon as these documents are sent to Petitioner.
