YOU WILL PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that appellant, Isaac Romell Williams, proceeding pro se, will respectfully move before this Honorable Court for a temporary preliminary injunction against the Broad River Correctional Institution (Broad River C.I.) staff and administrative officials for the following reasons:

On July 5, 2019, my appellate counsel, Taylor D. Gilliam, filed a Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari. I received a copy of this Petition approximately several weeks later. I then received a letter from this Court informing me that I had forty-five (45) days to file my own brief in response to the Johnson Petition. However, I was unable to meet that deadline because I have been — and still is — being denied access to the law library. On 4-15-18, then South Carolina Governor Nikki Haley issued a state-wide lockdown for all level 2 & 3 institutions because of an alleged riot incident that occurred at Lee C.I. I was not involved in that riot, was not at Lee C.I. when that alleged riot incident transpired, nor did I commit any infractions to warrant me being on 24/7 permanent state-wide lockdown. The Waterree Unit is on 24/7 permanent lockdown status and has been on permanent

lockdown status since 4-1-18. Because of this permanent lockdown status, the Wateree Unit C/O's and Broad River C.I. staff and administrative officials won't allow me access to the law library, satellite law computer, legal cases, law books, Jailhouse lawyers, etc. To further substantiate this allegation, Broad River C.I. staff and administrative officials won't allow law clerks or legal materials to be sent to the Wateree Unit. Moreover, I am not allowed to converse or commune with individuals who are versed in the law. I have asked Sgt. Thomas, Lt. A. Mingp-Lewis, Sgt. O, C/O Parrish, C/O Heyward, C/O Ramp, and any other officers that may work the Wateree Unit for access to the law library. Everybody says no. I show them my Court deadline documents and is still being denied access to the law library. The Wateree Unit Right Side cameras is evidence to prove same. Please review the Wateree Unit Right Side cameras for corroboration. I am unlearned in the law with an ~~eight~~^{twelfth} grade education. I don't have no family members, relatives, close friends, or any outside source to provide me with legal cases.

Conclusion

Wherefore, Appellant respectfully requests this Honorable Court issue an Order directing the Broad River C.I. staff and administrative officials to allow me access to the satellite law computer. Or, in the alternative, that I be moved to another unit so I can have access to the law library.

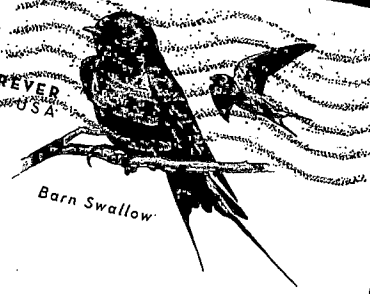
