ORDER

This appeal arises out of the appellant's conviction and sentencing on July 24, 2019. Counsel filed a proof of service showing service of the notice of appeal on August 21, 2019. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed for failure to show proof of timely service of the notice of appeal. *See State v. Devore*, 416 S.C. 115, 119, 784 S.E.2d 690, 692 (Ct. App. 2016) (noting the requirement for timely service of the notice of appeal is jurisdictional and this Court lacks authority or discretion to rescue the delinquent party by extending or ignoring the deadline for service); Rule 203(b)(2), SCACR ("After a plea or trial resulting in conviction or a proceeding resulting in revocation of probation, a notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents within ten (10) days after the sentence is imposed."). The remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
