
Dear Ms. Kitchings:


ORDER CONTINUING THE HEARING

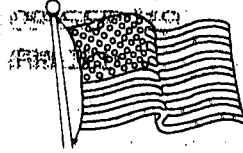

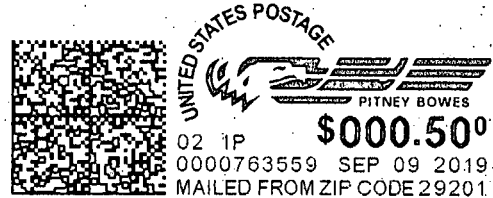
