

Appellant was tried before the Mullins Municipal Court for violation of S.C. Code Ann. 56-5-6520 (Failure to Wear Seatbelt). Appellant failed to appear at the trial and was convicted in absentia. Appellant has appealed on the grounds that Respondent failed to turn over video evidence prior to trial. As Appellant did not make this objection to the trial court this issue is unpreserved. The municipal court is affirmed pursuant to the following authority. City of Rock Hill v. Suchenski, 374 S.C. 12, 15, 646 S.E.2d 879, 880 (2007) (Circuit Court reviews summary court only for preserved errors), State v. Carlson, 363 S.C. 586, 595, 611 S.E.2d 283, 287 (Ct. App. 2005) (Failure to make contemporaneous objection to trial court renders issue unpreserved for appellate review).



# DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REFERENCE GUIDE

## I. Introduction

The Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), which can be found in Title 5 of the United States Code, section 552<sup>(1)</sup>, was enacted in 1966 and generally provides that any person has the right to request access to federal agency records or information. All agencies of the Executive Branch of the United States Government are required to disclose records upon receiving a written request for them, except for those records (or portions of them) that are protected from disclosure by the nine exemptions and three exclusions of the FOIA. This right of access is enforceable in court, and it is supported at the administrative agency level by the "citizen-centered and results-oriented approach" of a presidential executive order (see below).

The FOIA does not, however, provide access to records held by Congress or the federal courts, by state or local government agencies, or by private businesses or individuals. All states have their own statutes governing public access to state and local government records; state agencies should be consulted for further information about them.



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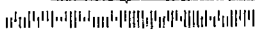
