Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Malik Jabree Singleton in the Court of Appeals on August 7, 2019. Counsel is preparing and consulting with Chief Appellate Defender, Robert M. Dudek, on the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the cases of State v. Therron Renard Richardson, and State v. William D. Pennington which he plans to file with the Court of Appeals in the upcoming weeks. Counsel is preparing and consulting with Chief Appellate Defender, Robert M. Dudek, on the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Greg K. Isaac v. The State which he plans to file with the Supreme Court on Monday.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that her caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. As indicated by the consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


