PETITION FOR EXTENSION

The Initial Brief of Appellant, and the Designation of Matter, in the above captioned direct appeal are due for service and filing on today's date, September 16, 2019. Due to her continuing medical issues, Counsel for Appellant has not been able to complete her work on this brief by this date. Counsel is in a lot of pain due to her deteriorating hip condition and has been able to work less and less in the last month. For that reason, she regrettably has no choice but to ask for an additional fifteen (15) day extension of time in which to file this Initial Brief and Designation of the Matter. Counsel's hip replacement surgery, originally scheduled for June 7, 2019, has been delayed due to continuing complications.


Thankfully, her physicians have now rescheduled her surgery for October 11, 2019. Counsel is committed to having this brief completed before she goes on full time medical leave approximately seven days before her surgery. Counsel has been advised by her surgeon that she will have to stop taking all anti-inflammatory medications by October 4, 2019. She may not be able to work at all past that date since she will be forced to rely on pain medications that will not be

Counsel had seriously hoped that she would have had sufficient time to complete the Initial Brief in this case after her last extension; however, she simply had not expected her condition to worsen over the last month. Counsel regrets the need for this additional extension, but assures this Honorable Court that she has done her best to avoid asking for it. She looks forward to returning to work in good health soon and will make a concerted effort not to need so many extensions in the future.

Counsel was unable to discuss this extension request with opposing counsel, William M. Blich, Jr., Senior Assistant Deputy Attorney General, in advance of mailing this petition for filing. She therefore asks that he make his position concerning this request known directly to the Court. As always, Counsel notes that she remains a sole practitioner and no longer has associates in her firm available to sign off on the necessity for this request.
