Collins & Lacy represents the interests of Respondents in the above-referenced matter.


Within recent weeks, the Court has advised the parties that this matter will be set for argument and that the argument date is October 10. This letter will serve as our request for the Court's consideration of our request to reset the argument for October 9. The reason for this request is this: Collins & Lacy is defending a complex matter in the Ninth Circuit, Court of Common Pleas, which is postponed for resolution. That matter was to have been mediated on September 5; however, due to the hurricane, the mediation was postponed. It was rescheduled for September 25; however, this week the mediator advised that he would be unable to conduct the mediation on September 25 due to a new conflict. We are advised that his next available date is October 10, which is the same date of the argument in this case, as currently scheduled. The matter in the Ninth Circuit really needs to be mediated as soon as possible for a variety of reasons. Accordingly, we would respectfully request that our argument be reset on October 9, so that the October 10 mediation may go forward.

I have confirmed with counsel for Appellants, Pedro E. Krompecher, III, and Edward L. Graham. By email yesterday (September 18), counsel advised that they would consent to a rescheduled argument in this case for October 9.
