Dear Mr. Garga-Richardson:

Upon reviewing your record on appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the case number is 2019-000389 and the names and addresses of all counsel in the case must be on the title page.
- The content is not in compliance with Rule 210(c), SCACR. Matter contained in the Record shall be arranged in the following order: title page, index, orders, judgments, decrees, decisions, pleadings, transcript, charges, exhibits and other materials or documents, and a certificate by the appellant. Each page shall be numbered consecutively, beginning with the index. Where a portion of a page of the trial transcript, or a page of an exhibit of document is to be included in the Record, the entire order, judgment, decision or pleading shall be included, to include the caption and signature. The Record shall not include matter which was not presented to the lower

court or tribunal, including but not limited to letters from the Court of Appeal and initial briefs.

- Index tabs are not needed for the Record on Appeal.
