

On Tuesday, February 5, 2013, Counsel had an oral argument in this Court in the case of State v. Manuel Marin. On Thursday, January 31, 2013, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in Antonio Williams v. State in the Supreme Court. On Friday, January 25, 2013, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Julian Deandre Battle in this Court. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in Sterling Green v. State in the Supreme Court on Monday, January 21, 2013. On Monday, January 14, 2013, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Heyward Robinson v. State in the Supreme Court and the brief of appellant and Record on Appeal in State v. Alfred Jackson in this Court. Counsel had an oral argument in this Court in the case of State v. Robert Jolly on January 10, 2013. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this Court in State v. Henry Lee Felder and the petition for rehearing in the Supreme Court in State v. Danny Cortez Brown on January 3, 2013. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in State v. James Miller in the Supreme Court on December 28, 2012. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Kevin Bennett were filed in this Court on December 28, 2012. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Ronald Jeffery Shows in this Court on December 19, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Dayvonn A. Valentine v. State in the Supreme Court on December 17, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of James Alexander v. State in the Supreme Court on December 12, 2012.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.




