NOW COME Appellants, Jennifer McFarland and Carlton Holcombe, by and through their undersigned counsel, on the grounds stated below, and, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, move for an extension of ten (10) days' additional time to file/serve their initial reply brief and corresponding designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.

Presently, by order of this Court filed September 13, 2019, the deadline for Appellants' initial reply brief and designation of matter is September 19, 2019. 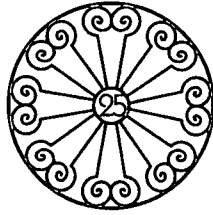

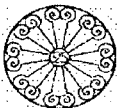
