Before the Court is Defendant's Motion to Reconsider the Court's previous order granting Plaintiff's Motion for Protection. On January 4, 2019, Plaintiff filed a Motion for Protection Against the Trial Preservation Deposition of Dr. Timothy Oury. The Court granted Plaintiff's motion on January 7, 2019.
