PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERIORARI

Petitioner, Alan Nix, petitions the Court for a writ of certiorari to review the orders, letters, and general conduct of the South Carolina Court of Appeals in the above cited cases beginning with the orders of 5 April 2018.

A petition for rehearing was timely made and apparently ruled on by order of 9 August 2019. There are motions that were outstanding at the time of the order of 9 August 2019 that have not been ruled on and a follow up motion of 19 August 2019, that has not been ruled on. Additionally, the Clerk of Court of the Court of Appeals has still not, as of the date of this Writ, even returned the Appellants stamped copy of the motion.

Without even an acknowledgment of the motion filed 19 August 2019, Appellant is filing this initial Writ of Certiorari on 9 September 2019 to ensure a timely appeal. The Writ will be amended as soon as possible to list all of the orders, letters, motions, and general conduct that the Appellant requests the South Carolina Supreme Court to review.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED FOR REVIEW

A preliminary list of questions are as follows:


1. Did the Court of Appeals improperly deny the Appellant's multiple requests to remand the case to the lower court to file Rule 60(b) motions?
2. Did the Court of Appeals improperly deny the Appellant's multiple requests to remand the case to the lower court to remedy questionable / fraudulent transcripts?
3. Did the Court of Appeals improperly restore the Appeal with the intent to prevent the Appellant from filing a Rule 60(b) motion in the lower court?
4. Did the Court act improperly when the fact the order restoring the case(s) lacked a Clerk of Court filed stamp?
5. Did the Court improperly consolidate appeals 2018-000056 and 2018-000174?
6. Did the Court act improperly by denying the Appellants' request to deconsolidate case numbers 2018-000056 and 2018-000147?
7. Did the Court break the Rules of Professional Conduct by taking improper actions to protect Judge Scarborough instead of appropriately reporting / managing his misconduct in office?

CONCLUSION

The Court should review the Court of Appeals conduct, orders and letters since 5 April 2018 to ensure appropriate conduct and rationale.




Additionally, be informed there are outstanding motions before the Court of Appeals that have yet to be ruled on / properly ruled on in these matters.
