Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Specifically, you must provide a proof of service showing that a copy of your notice of appeal has been served on the Clerk of Court for Richland County Court of Common Pleas. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- Please be advised that the argument you have presented in your notice of appeal is not proper in a notice of appeal. It must be removed and an

amended notice of appeal filed which is in compliance with Rule 203 of the SCACR.

- You must serve and file an amended notice of appeal that is substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
