- The designation of matter provided appears to be a list of documents given in the example format shown by Form 14 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Please be advised that you must provide a designation of matter in which you list any documents pertaining to this appeal that you wish to be included in the record on appeal.
- You must serve and file an amended designation of matter in which these corrections have been made.
- The time for serving and filing the respondent's initial brief and designation of matter will be calculated from the date of service for the amended appellant's initial brief and designation of matter.
