- The content of your brief must comply with Rule 208(b)(1). Specifically, your brief must include a table of contents and cases, statement of issues on appeal, statement of the case, argument, and conclusion.

- You must serve and file an amended appellant's initial brief substantially in the format shown by Form 13 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The time for serving and filing the respondent's initial brief and designation of matter will be calculated from the date of service for the amended appellant's initial brief and designation of matter.
