Dear Ms. Kitchings:

We wanted to advise the Court of the circumstances relating to the filing and service of Respondents Trinity Manufacturing, Inc. and Matrix Outsourcing, LLC's Final Brief in the instant case.

As the Court knows, Respondents Trinity Manufacturing, Inc. and Matrix Outsourcing, LLC have previously filed motions for extension to file the Final Brief. We sought these extensions because when preparing the Final Brief, it became apparent that there were materials cited in Respondents' Final Brief, which were not included in the Record on Appeal. This was a product of Respondent Univar's withdrawal from the instant case.¹ Accordingly, in order to include the materials referenced in this revised statement of facts, it was necessary for us to assemble a supplement or addendum to the Record on Appeal.

As this Court knows, this is a voluminous record. In our office, we have over 50 boxes of materials relating to the trial. At present, we would estimate that we have assembled approximately 90 percent of the materials necessary for the supplement to the Record on Appeal. We are missing only a few materials, and we have been in contact with Appellant's counsel to obtain the same.


We anticipate filing our brief no later than Wednesday-Thursday of this week, along with the supplement or addendum to the Record on Appeal. We will file these materials along with a motion for permission to file the same out of time, which presumably will be by consent.

¹ Respondents Trinity Manufacturing, Inc. and Matrix Outsourcing, LLC had incorporated by reference the statement of facts assembled by Respondent Univar. With Respondent Univar dismissed from the appeal, it was necessary for Respondents Trinity Manufacturing, Inc. and Matrix Outsourcing, LLC to amend their statement of facts to include verbatim what formerly had been incorporated by reference.
