This matter is on appeal from the Magistrate Court of Chesterfield County, South Carolina, the Honorable John A. Davis, Presiding Judge.

The defendant, Fritz Allen Timmons, was charged by Chesterfield County Animal Control March 1, 2013, with Uniform Ordinance Summons 1900, 1901 and 1901 for violating S.C. Code 47-1-40 which is commonly referred to as Ill-Treatment of Animals; Uniform Ordinance Summons 1884, 1885, 1886, 1887, 1888, 1898, 1899, 1903, 1904 and 1905 for violating 47-1-70 which is commonly referred to as Animal Abandonment or Neglect; and Uniform Ordinance Summons 1889, 1890, 1891, 1892, 1906, 1907, 1908 and 1909 of County Ordinance 415.60 which is commonly referred to as a Rabies Vaccination Violation.

The defendant entered a plea of guilty on Uniform Ordinance Summons 1889, 1890, 1891, 1892, 1906, 1907, 1908 and 1909 of for Rabies Vaccination Violations.

Chesterfield County was represented by Animal Control Officer Jim McGonigal.

The remaining charges were heard in a bench trial on March 18, 2013, and the notice of appeal was filed March 25, 2013.

The proceedings were recorded in writing by the judge.

The defendant made the following motion for dismissal on a lack of probable cause by the county to obtain a search warrant on the defendant's property located at [REDACTED] Road in the McBee area of Chesterfield County. The defendant cited state statute 17-13-141 claiming an anonymous e-mail sent to Chesterfield County Animal Control was not the basis for obtaining a search warrant.

The County stated the anonymous e-mail was used by Chesterfield County Animal Control to visit the defendant's property where conditions of animals kept outside and at-large were in plain view to animal control officers and a Chesterfield County deputy, who filed for a search warrant.

The Court denied the motion for dismissal.

The defendant made a motion for dismissal stating the warrant obtained by was not specific as to what property was to be searched at [REDACTED] Road.

The County stated there was only one dwelling on the property and the only to be searched.

The Court denied the motion for dismissal.

The County called the following witnesses:

Danielle Bowe, Chesterfield County Animal Control Director. Bowe testified she was present March 5, 2013, at [REDACTED] Road where animal control officers and county deputies entered the property by search warrant. Thirty-one canines, mostly dachshund breed, were on the property. Bowe stated multiple carcasses were found outside, one kennel was open with dogs at-large, a half-bag of food was found on the property and several water bowls were overgrown with a green algae-like substance and not drinkable.

Of the animals taken by county and examined by Hartsville Animal Hospital, canine "Juliet" tested positive for hookworms, was diagnosed with a skin infection and weighed 9 pounds, under average weight of 15 for her size. Canine "Hansel" was diagnosed with a skin infection and weighed 12 pounds, under average weight of 14 pounds for dog his size. Canine "Hanna" tested positive for hookworms and has tumors. Canine "Ethel" was diagnosed a severe overbite and was 9 pounds, which is under average weight of 11 pounds. Canine "Romeo" was treated for a skin infection and weighed 8 pounds, which is under the average weight of 15 pounds for a dog its size.


Bowe testified the mobile home on the property was not cleaned properly for low-stature animals like dauchand. Several dogs were enclosed in a bathroom without food or water with the toilet lid closed.

Upon cross-examination, Bowe testified no animals found by animal control tested positive for canine parvovirus (parvo). No canines taken by the county died in the county's care.

Bowe stated it was possible for dogs to knock over their water and food bowls, but those found on site were right side up. Bowe has never, professionally or privately, known dogs to become hungry enough to eat other canines.

Upon redirect, Bowe stated the hunger and underweight of the canines likely took place over an extended period of time.

The defendant called no witnesses and did not call himself to testify.

The court found the defendant not guilty on Uniform Ordinance Summons 1884, 1885 and 1886 for violating S.C. Code 47-1-40 which is commonly referred to as Ill-Treatment of Animals.

The Court found the defendant guilty of Uniform Ordinance Summons 1900, 1901 and 1901 for violating S.C. Code 47-1-40 which is commonly referred to as Ill-Treatment of Animals and Uniform Ordinance Summons 1887, 1888, 1898, 1899, 1903, 1904 and 1905 for violating 47-1-70 which is commonly referred to as Animal Abandonment or Neglect and imposed a sentence of \$3,000 in fines with scheduled payments.

2 MR. FOARD: Your Honor, the e-mail he is
3 referencing is on the second page of the magistrate's
4 return in the third paragraph. It is referenced
5 there.

6 THE COURT: All right. Now, let me just make
7 sure, this was not in part a civil case, this was
8 criminal only, am I correct?

9 MR. FOARD: Your Honor, yes it was. It was a
10 combination of violations of the State law and county
11 ordinance.

12 THE COURT: Very good. And you say the emails
13 are on what page?

14 MR. FOARD: The first couple of pages of the
15 return are the inventory and signature of the
16 magistrate. In the actual return itself, it is on
17 the second page, third paragraph. I will hand that
18 up to the Court if it would be quicker.

19 THE COURT: It would help me if you would
20 please.

21 MR. FOARD: Yes, Your Honor.

22 THE COURT: I see the e-mail.

23 MR. FOARD: The e-mail is not actually
24 contained in the return that is actually the only
25 reference to the e-mail.

26 THE COURT: All right, very good. Thank you.

1 I have that document. Let's do this. I don't have
2 that e-mail in my possession to give to you. But,
3 rather than getting hung up on that procedural
4 issue right off the bat, let me hear from you on the
5 basis of your appeal, and then we will make a decision
6 about evidence, and about law. Go ahead, sir. Tell
7 me what you believe happened below that would entitle
8 you to have this decision set aside.

9 MR. TIMMONS: Well, first of all my driveway
10 is a tenth of a mile long of which you cannot see
11 nothing in my yard. Therefore, any possible evidence
12 that could have been seen would have been conducted
13 under the constitutional intrusion, or by somebody
14 trespassing. Or, possibly completely tort in nature,
15 which animal resources using that as a probable
16 cause to --- for their search warrant. And then the
17 affidavit also does not support the search warrant.

18 THE COURT: Pull the microphone closer to you
19 so we can all hear. Thank you.

20 MR. TIMMONS: All right. Can you hear me
21 now?

22 THE COURT: A little bit better.

23 MR. TIMMONS: All right.

24 THE COURT: Okay. So, if you raise the issue
25 of trespass as you say, go ahead.

26 MR. TIMMONS: Well, that would be considered

1 as constitutional intrusion for the probable cause
2 that they are using. Second of all, the affidavit
3 that they used does not support their search warrant.
4 And, the tickets that were wrote was not filled out
5 and stuff at the time of the search.

6 **THE COURT:** All right, sir. Is there anything
7 else?

8 **MR. TIMMONS:** So they basically used ---
9 violated several violations of code, §17-13-141
10 several times in conducting the search and seizure,
11 which led to my reluctant release of custody of my
12 dog under unconstitutional conditions.

13 **THE COURT:** All right, sir. Is there anything
14 else?

15 **MR. TIMMONS:** I believe the supposed e-mail
16 was made up after the search warrant. Because, the
17 order that was given by the magistrate's court that
18 states, anonymous tip of poor conditions for more
19 than thirty canines of which only fifteen of the
20 canines were outside. All the others were inside,
21 and since I am the sole person that has been in my
22 house in the past four years, the only way that
23 anyone would have known of any other dogs would
24 have been after being inside my house, which the
25 only ones that would have would have been animal
26 services.

1 **THE COURT:** Yes sir. So, the only issue that
2 you raise is constitutional, that there was not
3 sufficient probable cause.

4 **MR. TIMMONS:** That, and the affidavit does not
5 support a search warrant.

6 **THE COURT:** So, you have no response then to
7 this very damning evidence which is in this file, of
8 pictures of dog carcasses, and unfed dogs, and
9 severely non-hygienic conditions. You have no
10 response to the evidence against you?

11 **MR. TIMMONS:** Now, the evidence for the no
12 food and no water, that is a false statement made by
13 animal control and the sheriff's department, in which
14 the pictures themselves shows where there is food and
15 water.

16 **THE COURT:** All right. Let's hear from the
17 State as to what your position is.

18 **MR. FOARD:** Thank you, Your Honor. I would
19 like to just first point out that we are in
20 possession of the notice of civil appeal filed by Mr.
21 Timmons on March 25, 2013.

22 However, we are not in possession of any motion
23 here today outlining exactly what relief he is
24 seeking in this matter, Your Honor, other than just
25 the general notice of appeal questioning the judgment
26 of the magistrate. But that being a side, Your Honor,

1 the notice itself is very unclear and does not state
2 with any kind of specificity, exactly what Mr. Timmons
3 is appealing.

4 As Your Honor can see from reviewing the return,
5 he was actually found not guilty of some charges;
6 guilty on others, and plead guilty to a third
7 section of charges, Your Honor. So I, as a
8 representative of the State, have no way of knowing
9 whether he is appealing his conviction, whether he
10 is appealing the conviction and the guilty pleas. I
11 don't know how to respond to that, Your Honor. I
12 don't know what he is seeking.

13 As far as the issues he has raised in his
14 notice of appeal, as well as the issues that you
15 raised here --- verbally here today, Your Honor, I
16 am not seeing any valid issues of law, or material
17 issues of facts that are addressable, and have been
18 preserved for you sitting in your role as an
19 Appellate Court to a review, Your Honor. There is
20 some indication that he did ask that certain
21 information be provided during the trial. He made
22 motions for dismissal based on certain things, but
23 those motions were denied by the lower court and we're
24 not preserved for appeal. Your Honor, I fail to see
25 what we are here about today. I know he is alleging
26 constitutional issues and obviously that is

1 technically an arena for an Appellate Court. But, if
2 they were not properly preserved, there is nothing for
3 the Court to review.

4 **THE COURT:** And let me hear from you on
5 probable cause, if I may. What information do you
6 have about probable cause?

7 **MR. FOARD:** Your Honor, as far as probable
8 cause, the affidavit contained in the return indicates
9 that, James Lewis the Affiant, did view malnourished
10 and ill-treated animals, and a lack of food. He
11 stated in the trial, which is contained in the return
12 of the magistrate, that this was a combination of in
13 plain view, and due to an anonymous e-mail that was
14 received, Your Honor.

15 The State will take the standpoint that the
16 anonymous e-mail gives animal control the right to
17 conduct a welfare check at the property, and whatever
18 was in plain view when they went to perform that
19 welfare check is valid inclusion, and is in an
20 affidavit for seeking a search warrant for further
21 examination of the property in question.

22 **THE COURT:** All right. Did you want to reply
23 to what you have heard, Mr. Timmons?

24 **MR. TIMMONS:** Yes. According to the affidavit,
25 the property that was sought is actually my address
26 and does not have nothing to do with animals. And

1 therefore, it does not support the search warrant.
2 Second of all, as to canines that were found, I
3 informed the magistrate that they was dug up, since
4 they died in 2012. They was either dug up by my own
5 dogs or by wildlife, and drug into the yard. And that
6 --- let's see. Also, the search warrant has duality
7 to it. So, it not known if they were going for
8 abandoned animals or neglected animals.

9 **THE COURT:** And just to make sure that I
10 understand, Mr. Timmons, you've received these
11 guilty verdicts and a fine, but you were not given
12 any active jail time; am I correct?

13 **MR. TIMMONS:** Correct.

14 **THE COURT:** All right, sir. Just one moment
15 please.

16 **(PAUSE)**

17 **THE COURT:** All right. Mr. Timmons, this is
18 the decision of the Court, sir. I am going to
19 respectively deny your appeal and dismissed it for
20 the following reasons.

21 First. I find that it is in artfully plead.
22 It is on a civil appeal form. It is not a criminal
23 appeal. This of course is a criminal case from below.
24 The exceptions to the judgment are not appropriately
25 stated.

26 But, based on what I have in your arguments today,

1 you have raised an issue of probable cause.

2 I find that there was sufficient probable cause
3 here. And that I have not been presented either
4 facts or law today which would require this Court to
5 reverse the decision below.

6 I would simply say to you though, sir,
7 respectively, that you are fortunate that you were
8 not sent to active prison time as a result of the
9 evidence that is here in this file. And, a better
10 result here would be simply to pay the fine and
11 proceed forward, and avoid this type of situation
12 for any animals in the future.

13 And that is the decision of the Court. Good
14 luck to you, and you may leave.

15 This appeal is dismissed.

16 **MR. FOARD:** Do you want me to do a form order?

17 **THE COURT:** Yes, I have written on the form
18 that the appeal is dismiss an appropriately plead,
19 and without merit. Have a good day.

20 Thank you.




