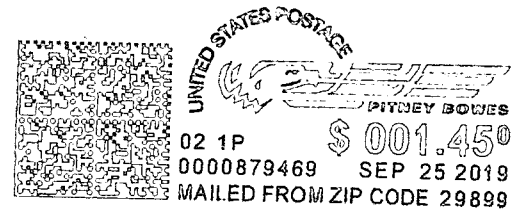
The state has continuously changed attorneys,
