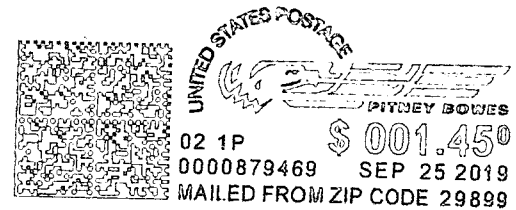
clear prejudice and discrimination is being held
