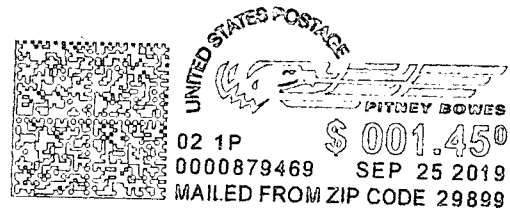
over five diverse Attorney Generals, since the commencement of the post conviction relief hearing has been on this case making frivolous filings on various briefs, aspects of this case.
