
Dear Mr. Baldauf:

Upon reviewing your initial brief of appellant and designation of matter, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter, or this appeal will be dismissed:
