ORDER

Petitioner has filed an explanation under Rule 243(c) of South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). To the extent the explanation relies on any claim relating to having to register as a sex offender based on the 2001 guilty pleas, those claims were rendered moot by the order of the court of general sessions filed on May 29, 2012. As to any other claims, petitioner has failed to show that there is an arguable basis for asserting that the determination by the lower court was improper.

Accordingly, this matter is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
