In The Appeal from the Administrative Law Court; The Record on Appeal was submitted on the 19th of September, 2019. However, the following deficiencies were noted;

- a. The caption/title did not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the case number.
- b. The content was not in compliance with Rule 210(c), SCACR.

Upon review, it became evident that the corrections can only best be accomplished by redoing the Record on Appeal to comply with Rule 210(c), SCACR. And this would require more time than the 10 days allowed for correction.


Your letter dated September 23rd, 2019 advising me of deficiencies encountered when reviewing the Record on Appeal submitted by me was received on the 25th of September 2019.

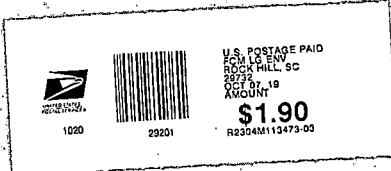
