

ORDER

Appellant has filed a notice of appeal, appealing the circuit court's "verbal order denying his motion, namely 'Defendant's Objection to Change of Venue to Jasper County.'" An order granting or denying a change of venue request is not immediately appealable. *See Breland v. Love Chevrolet Olds, Inc.*, 339 S.C. 89, 529 S.E.2d 11 (2000) (holding an order regarding a change in venue is not immediately appealable); *State v. Miller*, 289 S.C. 426, 346 S.E.2d 705 (1986) (holding a criminal defendant may generally not appeal until sentence is imposed). Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed.¹ The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
