**Appellants Motion for A Reinstatement**


In regards to Order of Dismissal dated: September 26, 2019. Pursuant SC Rule 240 and SC Rule 265,

Dear Honorable Deputy Clerk Allen,

Regards to The Record of Appeal approval for an extension August 07, 2019. I; (Janet L. West) am menopausal, and medically diagnosed with insomnia, anxiety, a.d.h.d, extreme depression. Since my menopausal began, I tend to have suicidal thoughts. A difficult time more so than past, to concentrate, eat, or sleep.

We are legal Shield members case #444542 and a local Columbia, S.C. law firm was suppose to be helping, however, told me they would not do the work for us, at the last minute. But, they would make notes on the records already sent to them. (Many records faxed and emailed to this law firm.)

I informed the lawyer; "That would be great! I would type The Record of Appeal, per their notes." Well, that did not happen, instead the attorney emailed SC Rule 210.

The Master/Order/Form 4; March 26, 2018 did not have all the procedures listed. The court hearing August 30; 2017 was presided by Judge Griffith, Aiken County Master-in-Equity, and contradictions of many hearings, filings and records, of procedure, per the time line of this case. 2015-CP-02-00578. (We received a DVD sometime after the August 30, 2017 hearing.) How do we proceed with giving the original or having a copy made to provide to SCCA?

Again, A case of fraudulent activities with multiple banks, identity thief, credit reports, no escrow at signing, the mortgage indicates Aames of California, the Note of Florida, The fabricated Assignment of Mortgage June 25, 2015 notarized by a notary of Louisiana, and The Nationwide Title Clearing, LLC of Florida not the title company performing the legal research of the chain of titles, etc. Instead, performed by Chase. (A recording approved by employee of NTC and myself, Janet West.)

The appraisal was argued at court hearing February 01, 2018. Through discovery of records received June 30, 2017 from Plaintiff s Senior Attorney William Stork, the appraisal was changed, without our knowledge. The Plaintiff's appraisal is fraudulent.

Also, The order Form 4 court presiding by Judge Early, the Plaintiffs did not follow through

with The Modification Intervention of The Administrative Order 2011-05-02-01. (I have an email from Plaintiff's Attorney confirming after the case, (We were not on the roster, however, received Order Form 4.) The Plaintiff's did not comply.



We will be filing a lawsuit with The Federal Court, regarding this case. As mentioned before, Fraud, under(State) and Federal Laws. We are trying our best to get The Record of Appeal filed. I am trying to keep my sanity and not take my own life.

Your cooperation and assistance is, has been truly appreciated.

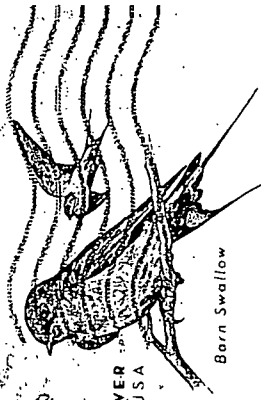

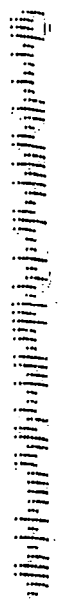


